

The Greenbelt Management Committee serves at the pleasure of the Crystal Lakes Road and Recreation Association Board of Directors. All final decisions are the responsibility of the CLRRA Board of Directors.

Greenbelt Management Committee
Charter

The five to seven members of the Committee serve by appointment of the Board of Directors of the Road and Recreation Association.

The purpose of the Committee is to maintain and enhance the beauty of approximately 1000 acres of greenbelts, forests, wetlands, and trails by:

- Managing the greenbelts in the best interests of the community.
- Coordinating infectious disease inspections and infected tree eradication.
- Contracting professional inspections, inventories and forest management procedures.
- Improving the quality of Tract H, Filing 11.

The five-year goal is an extensive cleanup and thinning of trees on greenbelts in five filings. This will demonstrate to all property owners how to lessen the danger of forest fire and encourage the growth of healthy trees.

This Charter will be reviewed every September and any revisions will be submitted to the Road and Recreation Board in October.
