### SAFETY AND SECURITY COMMITTEE

**TITLE:** Safety and Security Committee (the “Committee”)

**TYPE:** Standing

**PURPOSE:** To utilize volunteers, staff and others to discourage trespass by non-members of Crystal Lakes, and promote safety within the community, for property owners and guests, using non-confrontational means. All final decisions are the responsibility of the Crystal Lakes Road & Recreation Association (CLRRA) Board of Directors.

**AUTHORITY:** The Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Crystal Lakes Road and Recreation Association (“Declaration”), The Bylaws for Crystal Lakes Road and Recreation Association, the Articles of Incorporation for Crystal Lakes Road and Recreation Association and Colorado law.

**NUMBER OR MEMBERS:** The Committee shall consist of no less than three (3) members and no more than five (5) members.

**SELECTION OF MEMBERS:** Voting members are appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the CLRRA Board of Directors. A voting member must own at least one lot in Crystal Lakes and remain a member in good standing.

**TERM:** At the pleasure of the CLRRA Board

**MEETING FREQUENCY:** As Needed

**COMMITTEE ORGANIZATION:** The CLRRA Board will appoint the Committee Chair. The Chair selects the Members of the Committee and submits their names to the Board for approval.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Staff the security check point within the Community boundaries and maintain roving security check points throughout the subdivision in insure that all vehicles have member stickers or guest passes.
2. Provide roving patrols throughout the subdivision to encourage property owners and guests to comply with traffic safety and other regulations of the Association.
3. Prepare and submit meeting minutes of the Committee meeting.
4. Prepare a written monthly report for Association’s Board meetings and attend the meetings to answer Board Members’ questions and receive assignments from the Board.
