



**GLOBAL BROADBAND CORPORATION HAS APPLIED FOR A GRANT FROM THE COLORADO BROADBAND DEVELOPMENT FUND TO PROVIDE WIRELESS INTERNET SERVICE TO CUSTOMERS IN CRYSTAL LAKES AND OTHER RED FEATHER LAKES AREAS OF LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.**

Funds to build this system will be provided by DORA and the company. Low cost internet will then be available with download speeds up to 100mbps and upload speeds up to 50 mbps are anticipated.

**Denver, Colorado, November 30, 2018** – Nearly 800 rural homeowners in the Crystal Lakes subdivision of the Red Feather Lakes area in Larimer County could soon receive wireless broadband service should an application recently filed by Global Broadband Corporation be approved by the Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA).

Through the Colorado Broadband Development Fund, DORA funds grants to eligible companies to provide high speed broadband to un-served and under-served communities throughout the state. For each project that receives approval, the grant funds up to 75% of the infrastructure capital costs of new projects that would not otherwise be funded from other sources.

Under the application, Global Broadband Corporation of Denver would utilize leased tower space on Black Mountain, near Red Feather Lakes, to transmit and receive customer data using their proprietary WiDOX wireless broadband technology, which is able to provide high-speed broadband and has a coverage area of up to 3,750 sq. km from the tower. With this technology, Global Broadband proposes to provide Internet, VOIP telephone, and streaming video services within the proposed service area.

The Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA) is currently conducting a 60-day community comment period, which ends on December 21, 2018. After this date, the Board will rule on which projects will receive funding.
