This form is for the property owner to confirm compliance with the Crystal Lakes Road & Recreation Association Fire Pit Specifications and Open Fires Policy dated July 22, 2018.

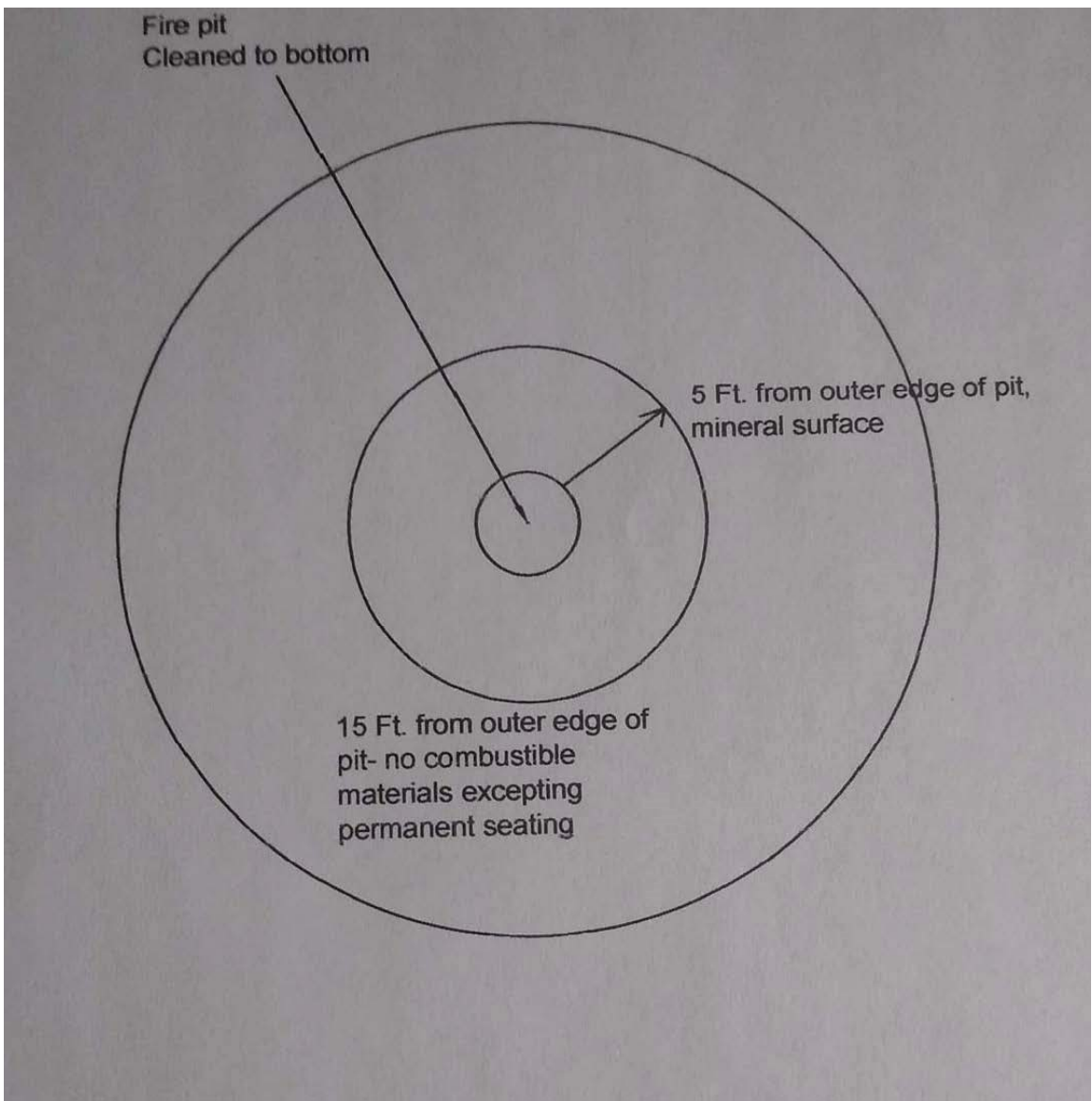
Please carefully consider the points below and initial compliance. A volunteer agent will verify your application.

Owner Initials	The red CLVFD address sign must be displayed at the entrance of the property . This sign identifies the lot and aids in locating the property for First Responders. Failure to display this sign will preclude inspection. (Signs available at the CL Office/\$7.00 donation to the CLVFD.) NOTES:	Agent Initials
	Fire Pit is constructed: solid walls with a minimum depth of 16" (inches). Fire Pit must be clean and free of ashes for the inspection. Note: If the pit is constructed of rock or brick, the inside must be sealed with masonry or a metal sleeve to prevent air flow. NOTES:	
	Fire Pit is not larger than 36" (inches) square, octagonal, or in diameter AND has a solid cover of non-flammable material that fits well enough to prevent embers from escaping, and heavy enough not to blow away or securable with non-flammable straps. NOTES:	
	There can be no flammable or combustible materials within 15' (feet) of the fire pit (includes, tall grass, trees, shrubs, buildings, propane tanks, etc.). Exception – Permanent wood benches outside of the 5' (feet) mineral area (see next item). Also, no overhanging branches within the 15' (feet) area up to 15' (feet) high. NOTES:	
	An area at least 5' (feet) around the fire pit is cleaned down to mineral soil to preclude vegetation or forest duff as an ignition source. (Refer to diagram on reverse side). NOTES:	
	All wood of any type must be stored outside the 15' (feet) area from the fire pit. (Refer to diagram on reverse side). NOTES:	
	Owner(s) accept responsibility for fire pit use by guests or renters. Reminder: Short Term Renters cannot burn in Crystal Lakes even in an approved fire pit.	
	Owner(s) have read, understand, and agree to comply with the CL Fire Pit Specifications and Open Fire Policy dated July 22, 2018.	
	Owner(s) understand and accept the responsibility to maintain the fire pit area according to the established Crystal Lakes Fire Pit Specifications and Open Fire Policy on an ongoing basis. Owner(s) understand that fines may be imposed for non-compliance.	
	Owner(s) agree to have at least a minimum of five (5) gallons of water (or charged hose) and a shovel located at fire pit when there is a fire present.
