

## Greenbelt Management Committee Meeting Minutes

Saturday, June 12, 2021, 10am – 12 noon (adjourned at 10:45)

**Present:** Carmel Mawle, Steve & Jane Koekeritz, Steve and Kellie Sponberg, Sarah Chaney

**Pilot Project/Mitigation:** The \$458,244 grant will allow 154 acres to be mitigated. \$20,693 of the matching funds are from volunteer hours. At \$29.5 per hour, that's approximately 700 hours over 5 years. In addition to the Basecamp and River Trail (big and not easy) mitigations, GMC will be mitigating two additional small tracts in filings 12 and 15.

**CWPP Update:** We're waiting on Water & Sewer to make a decision on Ember Alliance/Blue Mountain. W&S has committed to pay in proportion to their percentage of greenbelt. BOD asked Carmel to talk to other communities to see if they will help pay. Evan is going to reach out to two people he knows, but we need the decision about provider/costs to talk with them first.

**Trail work projects:** Colin Bonfoey – Scouts approved his proposal for the Midgard Trail. They have the logs for the bottom. He plans to bring a group of scouts up soon and have the bridge completed by August.

John and Julie Ryan would like to adopt the Bear Gulch Trail.

**Signage:** More signs are ready. Carmel will have signs made for the Volunteer Day.

**Education:** Carmel will update Greenbelt Website. Sarah Chaney plans to add entomology page. Carmel will prepare information for Volunteer Day.

**Other:** Lala reached out to the GMC for help with cleaning up area where there has been shooting by Tiny Bob. Forest Service land. More info to follow.
